Church Plant Report: August 2014

As I was drinking coffee, I could not stop from noticing this gentleman making his way in at the restaurant; his name is "Kip." With a big smile he was looking around trying to find "the best sit available." To my surprise, he sat down at the table next to me and from his lips emerged a big euphoric "hello friend." The greeting was followed by an apology for interrupting my reading about the two downcast disciples in their way to Emmaus (Luke 24).

Kip and I engaged in a friendly conversation about each other's life story. Soon after, he shared three things that stayed with me: First, his suffering from cancer. Second, his enjoyment of feeding a "big colony" of geese that gathers in a near by lake. Third, his car accident and how bystanders did very little to assist him. Then he provoked me even more with this phrase "I want to know more about God." My heart pounded at this point; then, he thanked me for dedicating a few minutes of my time to chat with him.

He took a sip of coffee and right there, he prompted this question: What do you do? I replied that I was planting a Hispanic Mennonite Church in Wichita. His eyes opened and asked me "Can I come to your church?" My Spanish is limited but I think that I can manage it, he added.

For the two disciples in Luke's narrative, their journey was heavy due to the latest development in their lives and town. They seemed to be disappointed and discouraged. It looks like their dreams and hopes were gone with it! On one hand, they hoped for Jesus to be the one who will save the world, but he was handed out to be crucified. On the other hand, they also had reports of his resurrection. They shared all this information with the "stranger" who joined them on their journey.

I resonate with both narratives; a genuine longing to experience God afresh! I am wondering how many more Kips are around us?

At Aposento Alto, we will continue "drinking coffee" as we join people's journey across the street. Please pray for us as we reach out to others like "Kip," people of peace.

As a missional community we resonate with the disciples to Emmaus: "Were not our hearts burning within us while he was talking to us on the road, while he was opening the scriptures to us?" (Luke 24:32 NRSV).
